

Things to remember before taking your trip



- Keep your documents with you in your carry-on luggage when you travel, not in your checked luggage
- Your study permit (and co-op work permit, if applicable) will be printed upon entry - take time to ensure the information on it is correct
- Dress for the weather, winters can be especially cold in Calgary

Things to remember before taking your trip

- Have the address where you are staying your first night handy
- Travel with snacks. Stores and restaurants may be closed at the time of your arrival
- Once you arrive, be sure to immediately call someone back home to let them know you have arrived safely





Calgary transit provides public transportation to and from the Airport.

- Route 100: Connects the Airport terminal to and from the McKnight-Westwinds LRT Station (LRT Blue Line)
- Route 300: Connects the Airport terminal to and from downtown Calgary

A boarding ticket must be purchased before boarding Calgary Transit vehicles

- Ticket machines are located at Door 15,
 Pillar 32, and Door 1, Pillar 7
- Debit, Credit and Canadian coins are accepted as payment
- Fares are marked on ticket machines (\$11.25 for a day pass)





Round-the-clock taxi service is available to and from the airport. standard municipal mandated fare rates apply. A typical fare any direction to and from the airport may range from \$40 and \$50. Fares vary however based on traffic, and distance traveled.

Taxi Stands can be found at the following locations at the airport;

- From the International Terminal, located on the arrivals level outside of doors 16 and 17
- From the Domestic Terminal, located on the arrivals level outside of doors 1 and 6.





The Transportation Network Company (TNC) Provides affordable transportation connecting passengers to and from the airport. After arranging your ride, you can meet your TNC driver at one of the designated zones – located on the arrivals level outside doors 1 and 12.

Authorized TNC operators at the airport include;

- Cowboy Taxi
- TappCar
- Uber



Alberta Health Care Insurance Plan (AHCIP)

Students studying in Alberta with a valid study permit may apply for the Alberta Health Care Insurance Plan (AHCIP) immediately upon arrival into Alberta.

STEP 1: Complete the Application form(S)

- Download the general application form for AHCIP coverage
- Download application form for AHCIP
 Coverage: Canadian Children of Non-Eligible
 Parents

STEP 2: Gather your supporting Documents
You must provide supporting documents
that prove:

- Alberta residency
- Identity
- Legal Entitlement to be in Canada

STEP 3: Submit the application

- In Person: Bring the completed application for and your original documents to an Authorized Registry Agent. There is no charge for this service
- By Mail: Send your completed application form and photocopies of your supporting documents to the AHCIP office;


